Pooled CO Code PSTN Report

- 1) If I confirm PSTN or delay PSTN for one or more CO Codes, will the confirmation screen display the tracking number for each CO Code?

The confirmation screen will display the tracking number for each CO Code where an action was taken i.e., Confirm PSTN or Delay PSTN.

Part 4

- 2) Is there a select all option to submit a Part 4?

There is no select all option provided, you will need to select the check box for each NPA-NXX or NPA-NXX-X where a Part 4 is being submitted.

- 3) If I move in my effective date, can I submit the Part 4 prior to the original effective date?

The Part 4 will be available to submit in NAS at the effective date of the CO Code or thousands-block and not before, this will account for effective date changes whether the date was rescheduled to an earlier date or a later date than the original effective date.

- 4) If the Part 4 due date has passed, will the CO Code or thousands-block still appear on the Submit Part 4 list?

When the Part 4 is past due for a CO Code or thousands-block, it will not appear on the Submit Part list. However, it will still appear on the Thousands-Block/CO Code Assignments Needing Part 4 Report.

- 5) If my Part 4 is past due, do I still need to send it to the appropriate regulatory authority i.e., FCC or State Commission?

For any Part 4 that is past due, you will continue to send it to the appropriate regulatory authority i.e., FCC or State Commission.

Thousands-Block/CO Code Assignments Needing Part 4 Report

- 6) Does the Thousands-Block/CO Code Assignments Needing Part 4 Report include CO Codes and thousands-blocks where the Part 4 is past due?

The Thousands-Block/CO Code Assignments Needing Part 4 Report includes all CO Codes and thousands-blocks where a Part 4 has not been submitted, this also includes CO Codes and thousands-blocks where the Part 4s is past due.

- 7) Can I pull the Thousands-Block/CO Code Assignments Needing Part 4 Report for all states?

There is a "Select All" option that can be selected for the "State".
